	Legislative Function:
	The Board shall exercise its rule-making power by adopting policies and procedures for the organization and operation of the Arts Academy Elementary Charter School. Those policies and procedures which are not dictated by the statutes or rules of the State Board or ordered by a court of competent authority may be adopted, amended or repealed at any public meeting of the Board of Trustees.

Executive Function:
The Board of Trustees shall exercise its executive power by the appointment of a Chief Executive Officer who shall enforce the statutes of the Commonwealth, the rules of the State Board of Education and the policies of this Board of Trustees.
Review:
Review: The Board of Trustees may assume jurisdiction over controversies or disputes arising within the school and concerning any matter over which the Board has authority granted by statute or where the Board of Trustees has retained jurisdiction in contract or policies. In furtherance of its adjudicatory function, the Board may hold hearings in accordance with law which shall offer the parties to a dispute, on notice duly given, a fair and impartial forum for the resolution of the matter.
