REVISED:

1. Procedures	 The Arts Academy Elementary Charter School seeks to conduct all procurement procedures: In compliance with stated regulations; and To prohibit conflicts of interest and actions of employees engaged in the selection, award, and administration of contracts.
	No staff member, trustee, officer, or agent may participate in the selection, award, or administration of a contract supported by a Federal, State, or local award if he or she has a real or apparent conflict of interest. Such a conflict of interest would arise when the staff member, trustee, officer, or agent, any member of his or her immediate family, his or her partner, or an organization which employs or is about to employ any of the parties indicated herein, has a financial or other interest in or a tangible personal benefit from a firm considered for a contract.
	No staff member, trustee, officer, of the charter school may solicit or accept gratuities, favors, or anything of monetary value from contractors or parties to subcontracts. However, the charter school may set standards for situations in which the financial interest is not substantial or the gift is an unsolicited item of nominal value.
