# **Expectations of Parents and Students**

- I. **Parents and Guardians:** Parents and guardians are expected to participate in their child's education in the following ways:
  - a. Communicate routinely and as necessary with their child's teacher(s).
  - b. Participate in developing their child's educational program at scheduled conferences.
  - c. Keep informed about School policies and their child's academic expectations, including homework.
  - d. Ensure that their child attends school regularly, arrives on time and is prepared for school.
  - e. Alert the School to specific problems or difficulties that may impede the child's learning or well-being.

## **II. Student Responsibilities:**

- a. The following are expected behaviors for students:
  - (1) Respect yourself.
  - (2) Work hard to stay on task.
  - (3) Do your best work.
  - (4) Be truthful and honest.
- b. Respect your teachers.
  - (1) Raise your hand to speak.
  - (2) Work cooperatively.
  - (3) Follow directions.
  - (4) Use only acceptable and courteous language.

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- c. Respect your fellow students.
  - (1) Support others in their learning.
  - (2) Keep your hands, feet and objects to yourself.
  - (3) Do not tease, curse, belittle, engage in deliberate attempts to embarrass or harm other students, threaten or fight with others, or engage in name-calling.
  - (4) Follow the disciplinary rules of the school
- d. Respect your building.
  - (1) Walk quietly in the hallways.
  - (2) Help keep the school clean and tidy.
  - (3) Spread good news about your school.
- e. Participate fully in the learning process.
  - (1) Report to school and to all scheduled classes regularly and on time.
  - (2) Remain in classes until excused.
  - (3) Pay attention to instruction.
  - (4) Complete assignments to the best of your ability and request help when it is needed.
- f. Dress appropriately.
- g. Maintain appropriate conduct on school buses when buses are used for transportation.
